

Memorandum of Understanding

between:

The Vienna Institute for International Economic Studies (wiiw)

and

Institute of Social Sciences in Belgrade (ISS)

Article 1

The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and education activities such as:

- Conducting joint research and development project,
- Cooperation in individual projects,
- Organization of lectures, symposia, international meetings, conferences, and workshops,
- Publishing scientific journals and monographs,
- Exchange of researchers and students,
- Exchange of information, teaching materials, technological and scientific publications,
- Providing opportunities for professors and researchers to give lectures,
- Search for opportunities to collaborate in the future.

Article 2

This Memorandum of Understanding does not constitute any costs to any of the parties involved in its implementation.

Article 3

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective immediately after signature by the representatives of both institutions and may be terminated by written notification by any of the parties.

The Memorandum may be amended by mutual agreement and an exchange of letters between the duly approved authorities of each institution.
